## Tax Credit Program

### Make a Difference in the Education of an HUSD Student and reduce your tax bill!

A.R.S. 43-1089 was enacted by the Legislature to give Arizona taxpayers the opportunity to support an extracurricular program at a school of their choice.

A tax credit is a dollar-for-dollar reduction in the actual tax owed. You may donate up to \$400 on a joint return or up to \$200 on an individual return; you then subtract those amounts from your tax bill. Taxpayers may bring their donation to Mountain View before December 19<sup>th</sup> or the District Office before December 31<sup>st</sup>.
