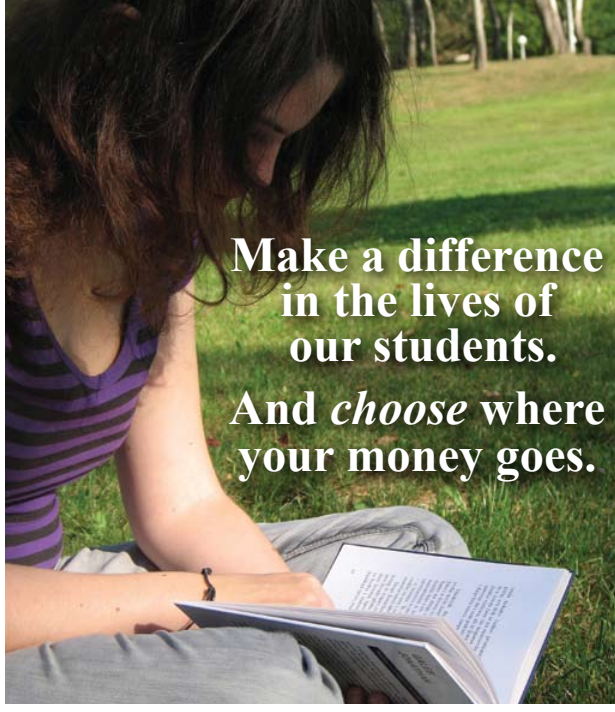

A.R.S. 43-1089 was enacted by the Arizona State Legislature to encourage taxpayers to support school extracurricular activities that are optional, non-credit, and educational.

This works as a dollar-for-dollar reduction in the actual Arizona State Tax you owe. You may donate up to \$400 for a joint return and up to \$200 for an individual return, then subtract those amounts from your tax bill. The due date for tax credit donations is Dec. 31 of each year.

We at The Humboldt Schools always do our very best to apply your donation as you specify. However, in the event that this isn't possible, your contribution will go to the Central Tax Credit Fund at the school you choose, to support other worthwhile and eligible activities.*
